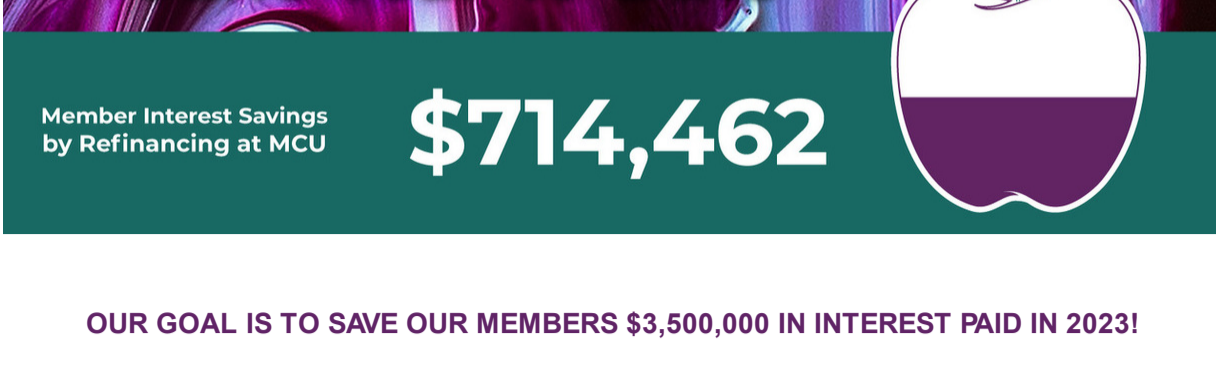
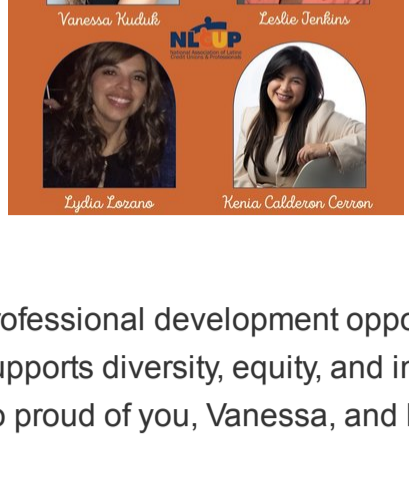

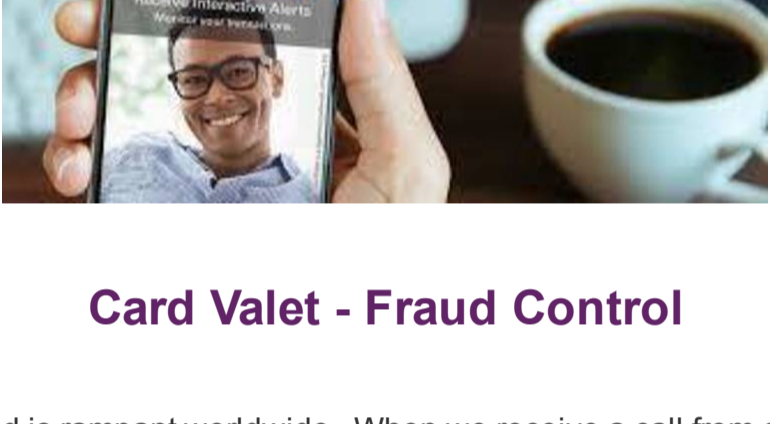

2023 Members CU Annual General Meeting Recap

Thank you to all who attended our AGM on June 6. We were pleased to welcome members and present three of our scholarship winners with their awards. After a delicious Venezuelan buffet Brian Wood, Chairman of the Board, welcomed everyone to the meeting, and Kathy Chartier gave the President's report highlighting our growth in assets, members, income, and capital and our community outreach. Because of our success as a Juntos Avanzamos and Community Development Financial Institution, we have earned a national, and international reputation as a best-practice credit union.

Vanessa Kuduk gave the loan report, announcing that we saved our members over \$3,000,000 in interest in 2022 by refinancing their auto loans and mortgages with us. Gerry Thompson, Supervisory Committee Chair, gave the supervisory committee report, explaining that through completed audits, they are confident that Members CU is a safe and sound credit union, and our members are well protected. 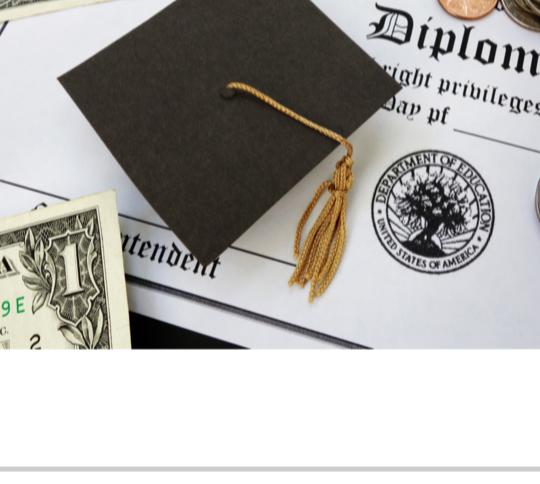


Card Valet - Fraud Control

Debit Card fraud is rampant worldwide. When we receive a call from our fraud department or one of our members that their card has been compromised, everyone loses. The member, because of time and inconvenience – you need to complete fraud reports and reissue a new card and, in some instances, close your account and transfer everything – all of your direct deposits, automated payments, etc.- to a new account. The credit union because your account is compromised because of fraud, and we are not able to recoup your losses – which is most often the case, we must take the loss.

Card Valet can help you control fraud very simply by putting controls on your debit card – turning your card on and off, setting location limits, tracking your transactions, and more. It is free and easy to use and available in the app store and google play. 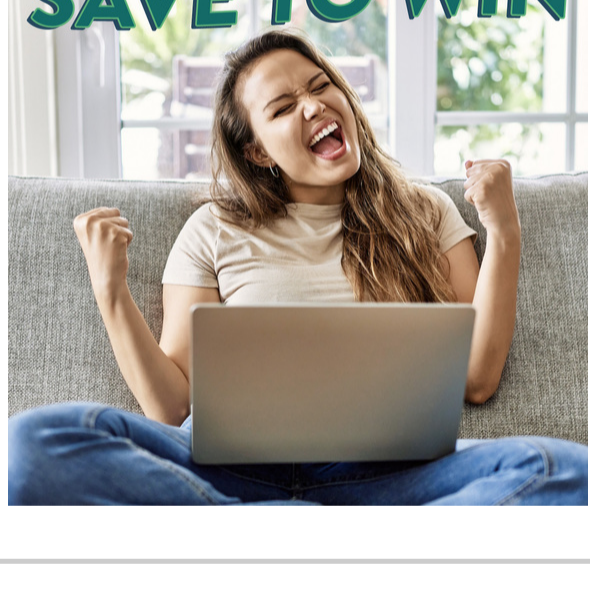

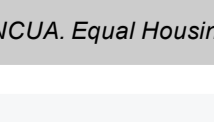

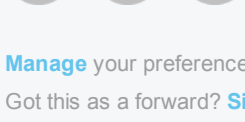
